- strengthen the ties between the different individuals and working groups which do monitoring in D-Grid
- discuss the possibility of a common interface for the different systems, pursue its development and installation
- coordinate the integration of the communities systems into the integration project DGI

Accompanying questions are:

- is it possible to find a common interface for the communication of the communities' metering and visualisation components in D-Grid?
- which data should be exchanged?

- translators
- portable sensor components for metering
- portable interfaces for visualization
- data delivery methods
- persistent caching of data and databases
- integrated monitoring architectures
